

## 2011 RMLSweb Project Recap

It's June already, and with 2011 reaching its mid-year mark, we thought we'd update you on our project progress for 2011. RMLS™ staff has been very busy completing project enhancements to the RMLSweb system. Here is a list of what we have accomplished so far this year.

### Items Accomplished:

- **Randomized MLS #s:** On January 1st, RMLS™ began using randomized MLS numbers (instead of sequential numbers). The first two digits of the number continue to indicate the year that the listing was added to the system.
- **Co-Listing Agent Access:** In January, we released the ability for Listing Agents and their Principal Brokers to grant permission for Co-Listing Agents to edit specific listings.
- **Quick Search on RMLSweb Mobile:** Allows searching on RMLSweb Mobile using Property Category specific fields.
- **Access RMLSweb site on Android devices and iPhones:** Users logging into RMLSweb through their Android phones or iPhones were given the ability to access the RMLSweb Mobile site or the full RMLSweb site (via buttons on the login screen).
- **Listing Load Compatibility with Firefox:** Allows users to access Listing Load using their Firefox browser.
- **New Photo Manager:** Allows uploading multiple photos at one time, adding captions to photos, automatic resizing to prevent distortion of photos and a drag/drop method for reordering photos.

We still have other big projects on our radar that we'll be turning our attention to. Here is a list of projects we will be working on during the rest of 2011 and into the new year of 2012:

### Still to Come:

- **Forms Change:** New fields will be added to the Listing Input Forms, as well as some edits to existing fields. New Supplemental forms will also be added.
- **Statistics Phase 2:** This project will provide subscribers a way to search on many of the fields in Advanced Search that produce statistical reports. Redesign of the Home Sales Report will provide additional statistics based on new construction versus existing home sales.
- **Listing Load Enhancements:** This project will address many of our subscriber concerns regarding the way a user enters and maintains a listing in RMLSweb.
- **Client Portal:** This would be a companion system to RMLSweb that would allow agents to provide private access for their clients where they can set up search criteria, run searches and comment on listings.
